

## **Baby Themed Pop Up Matchbox Card Giftcard Holder**

7-1/4" x 7-1/4" piece of Very Vanilla card stock	Envelope Punch Board
3-3/4" x 7" piece of Very Vanilla card stock	Stampin' Trimmer or Simply Scored scoring tool
5-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece of Very Vanilla card stock, for stamping images	Bone Folder

## FOR THE TRAY

Use the Envelope Punch Board and the 7-1/4" x 7-1/4" piece of cardstock to create the tray. Beginning at 3-1/8", punch and score all the way around as you would for an envelope. Then do it again beginning at 3-7/8".

You can visit <u>http://www.thecraftyowl.co.uk/boxbuster/</u> to figure out how to make boxes of different sizes with your Envelope Punch Board. Be sure to click on inches instead of mm.

Fold all score lines with a bone folder. There will be two on each side.

On one of the shorter sides, fold on the outer score line, insert into Envelope Punch Board, centered, and punch a notch. This will be the notch you use to pull the tray out from the cover.

Fold each side on the outer score line, then fold both layers over at inner score line.

Cut one side of the little square in each corner to form a flap. These flaps will hold up the sides of the tray.

Assemble the tray, gluing the points of the paper to the bottom.

## FOR THE INSERT

Score the 3-3/4" x 7" piece of card stock along the long side every 1/2" up to 4-1/2".

On the first 1/2" section, stamp the sentiment "...the world just got cuter!" in desired color.

From the stamped end, fold on the score lines in this pattern: valley, mountain, valley, valley, mountain, valley, mountain, valley, v

Adhere the insides of the mountains together. Then adhere the whole thing to the bottom of the tray, with the ridges at the notched end.

This will leave space in the back of the tray for a giftcard.

On the 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece of Very Vanilla card stock, stamp images from the two stamp sets that you want to pop up when the matchbox is opened. Use whichever combination of the three colors you'd like: Blushing Bride, Pool Party, Daffodil Delight.

I used Stampin' Write Markers to ink the multicolor toy, then "huffed" on it before stamping.

Use the Framelits to cut out the images.

Arrange and attach the cut images to the ridges in the tray. Be sure they all will fit inside the tray when they are pushed back flat. They must not extend past the sides or the very back.

Use strips of clear Window Sheets to attach "floating" images, like the booties in the example, and to firm up some others. This example had a 1-3/4" x 2-1/4" piece on the back of the onesies. This helps them pop up.

## FOR THE COVER

Score the 4-1/4" x 9-1/2" piece of card stock (in either Blushing Bride, Pool Party, or Daffodil Delight) along the long side at 1/2", 4-1/2", 5", and 9".

Fold all score lines with a bone folder. Adhere the two ends together to form the cover. Make sure the tray will fit inside. It should be snug enough so it won't fall out, but loose enough to slide easily.

Glue the 3-3/4" x 4" piece of DSP to the top.

Use the Decorative Label Punch to cut a piece of card stock in either Blushing Bride, Pool Party, or Daffodil Delight.

Use the 1-3/8" Scallop Circle Punch to cut a piece of card stock in either Blushing Bride, Pool Party, or Daffodil Delight. Adhere to the center of the Decorative Label punched piece.

Stamp the sentiment "Congratulations" on a piece of Very Vanilla card stock and cut with the Washi Label Punch. Adhere over the other two punched pieces.

Put adhesive on both ends and adhere to the cover so that the piece of ribbon will slide vertically under it.

Tie the ribbon in a bow.
